FEE STRUCTURE FOR DOMESTIC ADOPTION – OUT OF DIOCESE

The Diocese of Baton Rouge subsidizes the services provided to families who reside within the Diocese of Baton Rouge. Other Dioceses do not subsidize our services, therefore, higher placement and post placement fees must be charged to ensure that these adoption services are available to those who reside outside the civil parishes (Ascension, Assumption, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Iberville, Livingston, Pointe Coupee, St. Helena, St. James, Tangipahoa, West Baton Rouge, and West Feliciana) of the Diocese of Baton Rouge.

Pre-Application Fee, non-refundable \$100

Training Program Fee, non-refundable \$750
To be paid on or before the first training session

Technology Fee, non-refundable \$250
Paid to myadoptionportal.com to open your online adoption application

Home Study Fee, to be submitted when the online application is complete, prior to home study:

Non-refundable home study fee for first agency adoption \$2,000

Non-refundable home study fee for second CCDIOBR adoption \$750

Non-refundable home study addendum fee \$250

(per state regulations, home studies must have an addendum every twelve months)

Travel Fee, one time fee assessed before first home visit to cover travel time

120-179 miles round trip:	\$100
180-239 miles round trip:	\$150
240+ miles round trip:	\$200

Mileage Fee (out of Diocese) Invoiced after visit 0.52cents per mile

Life Affirming Fund, to be paid at time of Home Study Approval \$1,500
The fund allows us to provide financial assistance to more expectant women in crisis, therefore aiding them in making a life-affirming choice for their unborn children. The fee is NOT tied to an adoptive placement or to adoption, but to benefit all expectant parents with whom Catholic Charities works.

Placement Fee \$16,500 – 38,750

The Placement Fee is charged *when a child is placed* in the adoptive home. **The fee is calculated as 25% of the family’s adjusted gross income** for the tax year immediately preceding the home study (or home study update) after the minimum fee of \$16,500 has been met. The fee cap is \$38,750. The fee is due in full at the time of placement. The fee goes toward defraying the administrative and operating costs of the agency, including counseling services and assistance to the birth parents.

If placement occurs through Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Baton Rouge in conjunction with another agency, the fee schedule from that agency may supersede that provided by Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Baton Rouge. This may mean fees are higher than those presented in this document. You will have the opportunity to review these fees prior to making a decision to allow your profile to be shown.

Court and attorney fees, approximate \$1,500-\$3,000
 To be submitted after placement, prior to finalization, directly to the attorney

State Police Fingerprint Fee \$10 per adult applicant

State Criminal Background Clearance \$26 per adult applicant

FBI Criminal Background Clearance \$18 per adult applicant

Court Appointed Curator fee, if appointed by judge - varies by parish, \$525 in East Baton Rouge parish

Medical Clearances as per client’s MD

Other adoption related costs: variable
 Psychological evaluation fee, if determined necessary

An evaluation with a Therapist/Psychologist may be required at the discretion of the Department or Clinical Director upon consultation with the case worker completing the home study. The approximate cost is \$600 and is paid directly to the Therapist or Psychologist.

Post Placement Supervisory Visits: \$250 per visit

Per agency policy, a home study must be updated annually based on state and child placing agency regulations. These regulations also stipulate that a placement cannot occur in the home if the home study is more than twelve months old. This update includes updates to criminal and child abuse clearances, as well as annual DCFS online trainings and it addresses any changes in the home.

Note: Unless otherwise stated, all fees are payable to “Catholic Charities Diocese of Baton Rouge.”
